Toddler Room: Based on observation during a tour of the Toddler Room on 1/17/13, the surveyor observed a bottle on the mat beside a sleeping child. Through interview with a staff, the surveyor learned that the child was permitted to lie on the mat and drink the bottle before going to sleep. Drinking while lying down increases the risk for choking and ear infections.

Findings:

Toddler Room: Based on observation during a tour of the Toddler Room on 1/17/13, the surveyor found that three (3) toddler children were not wearing shirts while sleeping on their mats. Through interview with a staff, the surveyor learned that the children had soiled their shirts while eating Sloppy Joes for lunch and their shirts were being laundered. Additional clean clothing was not available for the children.

Toddler Room: Based on observation during a tour of the child care center on 1/17/13, the surveyor found that an eleven month old child was being provided care in the office area. The child was placed in an infant seat in a reclined position. The staff person gave the child a bottle to drink while in the reclined position. The infant child was not held for bottle-feeding.
