Findings:																																																							
<p>General: Based on interview, the child care center failed to comply with staffing requirements. Interview with multiple sources revealed that there were occasions in the mornings that the four-and-five-year-old room did not maintain minimum staff-to-child ratios. Interview revealed one morning there were at the least twelve (12) children with one (1) staff member and the youngest age child in the room was two-years-old.</p>
