Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. The Younger Preschool Room (Room 106) contained two uncovered electrical outlets next to the sensory table.
- 2. The Younger Preschool Room (Room 106) contained a section of the electrical conduit, on the lower part of the wall, that was separated, and the wire was exposed. This was located next to the library area.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A staff hired on 5/13/2022, did not have proof of education on file.

435 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A staff member hired on 7/23/2013, completed fourteen of the fifteen hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training between 7/01/2021 and 6/30/2022. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed and confirmed these findings.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. The Two-Year-Old Room contained a hole in the wall above a shelf that contained musical instruments.
- 2. The entranceway of the center contained a water leak in the ceiling. The water was dripping into a plastic bucket on the floor. A small hole was observed in the ceiling where the water was dripping. The staff in charge indicated that it was from a new HVAC unit that was recently installed.

695 - Toilet Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and
- (d) Have ventilation to outside air.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The bathroom between the Preschool I and the School-Age Room contained feces and urine in the toilet.

- (20) An outdoor play area shall be:
- (d) Safe from foreseeable hazard;(e) Well drained;
- (f) Well maintained;
- (g) In good repair; and
- (h) Visible to staff at all times.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The outdoor play area contained areas where the landscape fabric was exposed from the mulch. This is a tripping hazard for the children. In addition, the outdoor play area contained areas with numerous weeds that were growing through the blacktop and around the landscaping timbers

922 KAR 2:120. Section 13. Toys and Furnishings.

- (1) All toys and furniture contacted by a child shall be:
- (a) Kept clean and in good repair; and
- (b) Free of peeling, flaking, or chalking paint.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. The Toddler Room contained a blue child-size chair in the library area that was torn in three spots on the cushions.
- 2. The Toddler Room contained tape residue on the front of two drawers (by the counter) that was storing art supplies.
- 3. The Two-Year-Old Room contained a circle alphabet rug that was frayed around several of the edges.
- 4. The Preschool 1 Room (Room 107) contained a wooden cabinet in the dramatic play area that the top hinge of the cabinet was no longer attached.
- 5. The School-Age Room contained a shelving unit with an excessive amount of crayon and marker marks on the back of the unit. The shelf contained art supplies.

- 1. The One-Year-Old Room contained two dusty vents on the ceiling. One was located above the diaper storage area, and one was located above the block area.
- 2. The bathroom in the Two-Year-Old Room contained a dusty vent and light fixture in the ceiling.

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The Younger Preschool I Room (Room 106) and the School-Age Room did not have lesson plans posted.
