Findings:

General: Observation of the preschool outside playground revealed there was a large climbing apparatus that did not have sufficient protective surfacing around and under the structure. The black landscape material was visible. Observation of the large playground revealed there were two (2) sets of monkey bars that did not have sufficient protective surfacing under them. There was dirt visible. Further observation of the large playground revealed a large climbing apparatus with a beige slide that did not have sufficient protective surfacing at the foot of the slide. There was dirt visible.

- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;
