Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:400E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor observed two (2) staff persons on the playground with children. The two (2) staff were not wearing a facemask with children running around them. Therefore, the proper Personal Protective Equipment was not being utilized.

This deficiency was cited due to the following E-Reg: 922 KAR 2:405E

Section 8. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Requirements. (1) Each adult, including parents and guardians at drop-off and pick-up, shall wear a facemask while inside a child care center: (a) Unless doing so would represent a serious risk to their health or safety and they are able to present a medical statement stating this; (b) Except during planned staff breaks and lunch away from children in care and other staff.
