Findings:

School age: Based on Review of Documentation, the facility has a written policy that they will administer sunscreen. The parents are required to fill out a form giving the facility permission to apply the sunscreen. The form only asks for the brand of sunscreen. There are no instructions provided by the parent as to when the sunscreen is to be applied. In addition, the facility does not document the time the sunscreen was applied.

2) Date Not In Compliance

Findings:

School age: Based on Review of Documentation, the facility has a written policy stating they will administer sunscreen. However, there is no date documented by the parent as to when the sunscreen is to be administered. In addition, the facility does not document the date the suncreen was applied by staff.

3) Amount Not In Compliance

Findings:

School age: Based on Review of Documentation, the facility has a policy that they will administer sunscreen. However, there is no documentation by the parents as to the amount of sunscreen to apply. It was also found that staff do not document the amount of sunscreen applied.

4) Staff name Not In Compliance

Findings:

School age: Based on Review of Documentation, that staff do not doument the name of the staff person who applied the sunsreen.

Findings:

school age: Based on Observation, there was one (1) child observed sleeping on the gym floor while the other children were watching a movie. The child was covered up with a blanket. An interview with the staff person in charge found that they have mats available. However, the child observed sleeping was lying directly on the gym floor.

school age: Based on Observation, at the time of the visit a child was observed sleeping directly on the gym floor. The child was covered with a blanket. An interview with the staff person in charge found that there are mats available but they do not have sheets to cover the mats.
