Findings:

General: Based on Observation, several school-age children were observed being dismissed from the cafeteria to go to the office to meet their parents for pick-up during the complaint investigation. The cafeteria is on the second floor of the building and the children must walk down a hall to an enclosed stairwell and then at the bottom of the stairs they exit a door that leads to the office. The school-age children were not in sight or sound when they exited the cafeteria and went to the office.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a staff member did not have a personel file on site at the facility. It could not be determined when the staff member was hired with the after-school program. Based on conflicting interviews it was unclear if this staff member ever worked alone with the children.
