Findings

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the toilet seat moved easily and was not tightly secured to the toilet in the restroom located on the right side of the hallway near an exit door; therefore, the toilet was not kept in good repair.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found stains on the diaper changing pad and debris on the diaper changing table underneath the diaper changing pad in the One Year Old Classroom; therefore, the diaper changing surface was not clean.

General: Based on observation of the playground, the surveyor found no protective surface around a large climbing structure with four (4) slides. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that they had planned to put mulch around the climbing structure and slides.
