Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470; 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19); 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a staff member hired on 1/3/17 did not have written evidence of completing a CAN check or criminal records check. Another staff member hired on 1/17/17 did not have written evidence of completing a CAN check. Based on observation neither staff member was working alone with the children.

1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;

2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and

3. To contain:

a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;

b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:

(i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;

(ii) Family physician; and

(iii) Preferred hospital;

c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;

d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:

(i) Allergies;

(ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and

(iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;

e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency situation involving or impacting the child;

f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, two (2) children's files were missing the physician's phone number and one (1) child's file was missing the physician's name and phone number.
