The list was accessible and within view of anyone who entered the classroom.

General: Based on observation of the infant classroom, there was one (1) child (DOE: 8-5-16) that had a pacifier clip attached to their clothing while they were laying down in the crib. Based on review of documentation of the child's file, there was no written documentation from a medical professional regarding the child wearing the pacifier clip in the crib.

General: Based on interview, the mouth contact toys in the infant classroom are not sanitized properly, i.e., staff stated mouth contact toys are placed in soapy water, air dried, sprayed with bleach water, and then air dried again.
