- (1) A child care staff member shall complete the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and be found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member.
- (2) A current or prospective child care staff member shall be subject to background checks in accordance with Sections 4 and 5 of this administrative regulation at intervals pursuant to 45 C.F.R. 98.43(d).

Findings:

General: Based on observation, one (1) staff in the Toddler Two classroom did not have evidence of a cleared background check in KARES. The staff was present but not working alone on the day of inspection.

General: Based on observation, one staff (1) in the Toddler Two classroom did not have evidence of background check being submitted to KARES prior to employment.

General: Based on observation, one (1) staff in the Toddler Two classroom, did not have evidence that she had submitted fingerprints at the time of inspection.

General: Based on observation, this regulation was not met. During the walkthrough, seven (7) of the classrooms did not have their cots spaced 12" apart for nap time.

General: Based on observation, this regulation was not met. One (1) of the buses did not have a completed daily inspection log and the log for another bus ended on 8/18/22.
