General: Based on review of documentation, staff member hired 10/17/19, had a negative tuberculin skin result that was dated 8/21/2019. This record exceeds two years and is no longer current.



435 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on review of documentation, staff member hired 10/19/2015, completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma on 4/20/2016. This exceeds five years and is due to be retaken. A review of ECE-TRIS supports this finding.
