# 225 - Licensee Responsibility

- (1) A licensee shall:
- (a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and
- (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

#### Findings

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. In Classroom 209, there was a set of black cords hanging down from a mounted T.V.; the cords were loose and not secured to the wall.
- 2. In Classroom 209, there was one (1) bottle of hand sanitizer that stated "Keep Out of Reach of Children" located on a silver cart.
- 3. In Classroom 202, there were three (3) black cords loosely coming from a mounted T.V. and a black DVD player. The cords were observed to be not secured to the wall and were hanging down over a table that children were utilizing.
- 4. In the gym, there was a metal chair rack that had several chairs hanging from the rack.
- 5. In the hallway leading to the playground, there was a stack of three (3), a stack of five (5), and a stack of six (6) white long tables leaned against the wall and a metal rake.

Each of the items mentioned were accessible to children and compromised the health, safety and comfort of the children.

- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following staff's (DOH: 11/01/09, 02/01/19, 09/01/14, 03/31/21, 07/30/18, 01/14/19 and 07/21/20) file did not contain documentation of a current TB skin test or a statement from a health professional stating that the adult was free from active tuberculosis.

Staff-in-charge stated that she was not sure if they had a current TB Skin Test.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following in an unlocked black cabinet located behind the classroom door in Classroom 203: two (2) Up & Up disinfecting wipes, one (1) spray bottle of Banana Boat Sunscreen, one (1) spray bottle of Window Cleaner, one (1) canister of shaving cream, one (1) Antibacterial Redi Wipes, and one (1) container of Clorox Wipes.

Each of these items stated, "Keep Out of Reach of Children." The surveyor observed these items to be within reach of children.

625 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the walls in the downstairs boys' restroom had rust that was flaking off of the wall; therefore, the restroom wall was not kept in good repair.

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The following children's (DOE: 01/04/22, 01/05/22, 01/10/22, 03/29/22, 03/07/22, 05/09/22, 02/19/22, 01/05/22, 01/04/22 and 03/01/22) files did not contain the contact telephone numbers for the child's preferred family hospital.
- 2. A child's (DOE: 05/09/22) file did not contain the name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child,
