General: Based on Review of Documentation, a caregiver hired on 1/4/17, had no documentation of education on file.

- (a) Be at least twenty-one (21) years old;

- b. Driver history records through the state transportation agency that issued the driver's license;
- (c) Hold a current driver's license which has not been suspended or revoked during the last five (5) years; and
- (d) Not caused an accident which resulted in the death of a person.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a driver hired on 6/6/11, had a driver's history record dated 9/29/15. It was previously noted the driver had a record dated 9/17/16; therefore, the most current driver's history record was not maintained.
