General: Based on review of documentation and ECE-TRIS, the surveyor found no verification that a staff (DOH: 05/31/16) completed six (6) hours of cabinet approved orientation training within the first three (3) months of employment.

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that children in the classroom for the four and five-year-old children were watching the animated program, Smurf Christmas. Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that the animated program was not listed as part of the child's daily planned program of activities.

General: Based on interview during a tour of the three and four-year-old children's classroom, staff informed the surveyor that the children's bedding is changed every two (2) weeks rather than weekly or as needed.

- 1. The surveyor was unable to determine the interior temperature in refrigerator located in the Toddler Room as the thermometer was broken.
- 2. The interior temperature of the freezer located near the copier measured at five (5) degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, not within regulatory compliance.
