922 KAR 2:090. Section 8. General.

- (1) A licensee shall:
- (a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and
- (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor discovered the following in the hallway beside the exit to the playground:

- 1. Three (3) jackets and eleven (11) backpacks were touching and placed on the floor.
- 2. Seven (7) jackets were placed on wall hooks and were touching.

Thus, there created a potential for cross-contamination; therefore, the health, safety, and comfort of the children were compromised.

Staff-in-charge stated that the school-age children bring their backpacks/jackets and place them in the area prior to going upstairs. Staff-in-charge stated he would figure out a place for the children to place their items in the evenings.

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:
- 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

General: Based on interview with the staff-in-charge, the surveyor discovered that the personnel file for one (1) staff (DOH: 6/14/22) did not contain documentation of education in the form of a high school diploma, GED, or Commonwealth Child Care Credential.

435 - Training **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discovered the following:

- 1. Upon review of the ECE-TRIS Required Training Hours Report for the timeframe of 9/13/21 thru 9/12/22, the surveyor discovered that one (1) staff (DOH: 9/13/21) had completed thirteen (13) hours of the fifteen (15) required hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training.
- 2. Upon review of the ECE-TRIS Required Training Hours Report for the timeframe of 9/7/21 thru 9/6/22, the surveyor discovered that one (1) staff (DOH: 9/7/21) had completed four (4) hours of the fifteen (15) required hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training.

Therefore, the child-care center failed to ensure that training was completed as required.

(3) A sink shall be:

690 - Sink

- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the hot water temperature of the sink located in the Three Year Old Classroom had a temperature reading of seventy-seven (77) degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the water temperature of the sink did not fall within the required minimum ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and maximum one hundred and twenty (120) degrees Fahrenheit.
