- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1.) Four staff did not complete the required 15 hours of annual training between July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021.
- 2.) One staff hired on 2/14/19, did not complete the the required Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training within the first year of employment.
- 3.) One staff hired on 9/12/19, completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training on 9/29/16; however, did not renew the training due by 9/29/21.

A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed these findings.
