Findings: General: Based on observation, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. In the gym area, the electrical outlets were observed to be uncovered.

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements. (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following: (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment; (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.	
Findings: General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. The child care center did not produce verification from the Early Care and Education Training Records Information System (ECE-TRIS) that a staff member with a hire date 11/23/2015 received fifteen (15) hours of annual cabinet approved early care and education training. In addition, the director disclosed that the above-mentioned staff member did not complete the fifteen (15) hours of required annual training due to illness.
