General: Based on Interview, on 5/9/13 a staff person tripped on a bucket of children's books while carrying a three (3) month old child. The staff person fell and the child's head hit the carpeted floor. The child sustained a concussion and a skull fracture as a result of the fall. The child is expected to make a full recover with no long term effects from the injury.
