General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Room 243 (Toddler 1) contained an area of chipped paint on the wall next to the toy tool bench. Another area of chipped paint was also observed above the tool bench with a piece of clear packing tape holding the paint on the wall.

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:
- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;
- (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;
- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. The 2008 Ford E250 and the 2009 Ford Super Duty vehicles used to transport the children would not start during the renewal inspection. Based on interview with the staff in charge, they have not used the vehicles since 2008, but the center would like to keep transportation services on the license. Indoor and outdoor equipment shall be in good repair.
- 2. The Room 224 (Toddler 1 A) contained a blue mat with a tear on the corner. The foam was exposed on the corner of the mat. The mat was located in the home living area.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Room 220 (Toddler 2) and Room 221 (Toddler 4) did not have thermometers in the freezers; therefore, the temperature of the freezers could not be determined. There were popsicles for the children stored in both freezers. Frozen food shall be kept at zero degrees Fahrenheit or below.
