- 1. A laptop placed on a shelf with the charging cable plugged into an outlet behind a child size chair in the Preschool Classroom. The charging cable was observed to be accessible to the children.
- 2. A large box placed near the exit door in Classroom 113. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that Classroom 113 has not been in use due to a shortage in staff.
- 3. Children's shelving placed underneath a large black box attached to the wall with a red sign on the front of the box that read "First Aid Kit."

The laminator was observed to be within reach and accessible to the children. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that Classroom 113 has not been in use due to a shortage in staff.
