#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor observed a staff person wearing their PPE facemask under her nose. Therefore, the proper Personal Protective Equipment was not being utilized correctly. Staff stated she will go over how to wear PPE facemask correctly with staff.

This deficiency was cited due to the following E-Reg: 922 KAR 2:415E Section 8. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Requirements. (1) Each adult, including parents and guardians at drop-off and pick-up, shall wear a facemask while inside a child care center: (a) Unless doing so would represent a serious risk to their health or safety and they are able to present a medical statement stating this; (b) Except during planned staff breaks and lunch away from children in care and other staff.
