Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and Interview the childcare center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request the director did not present verification that the criminal records check (CRC) had been completed for the employee with the hire date of 03/07/2016. The employee was not observed working alone, the employee was present with two (2) additional staff members.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request the director did not present verification that the employee with the hire date of 08/09/2014 had met the requirement of fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment. Review of documentation in the ECE-TRIS training system revealed the staff member listed above had not met the
