- 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. A review of staff files during the inspection found two (2) staff that did not have the date of employment listed in their file. The staff person in charge reviewed internal documentation and then identified 3/31/18 and 4/1/18 as the hire dates.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on Review of Documentation and the Training Records Information System (TRIS), two (2) staff files (hire dates: 12/14/15 and 9/5/16) did not contain the required fifteen (15) hours of training.
