(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

1.) A staff member hired 9/7/2021, did not complete the required Orientation. This staff member has been employed for more than three months.

2.) A staff member hired on 11/10/2020, did not complete the required Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training. This staff member has been employed for more than one year.

3.) A staff member hired on 2/15/2006, did not have evidence of completing 15 hours of annual early care and education training.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found no written evidence of completed Tornado or Earthquake Drills since March of 2020. The staff person in charge stated that school made a decision not to practice those drills due COVID-19, as children would have to be close together in the small space.
