General: Based on Observation the child care center failed to comply with staffing regulatory requirements. Observation of the facility was conducted on September 11, 2015, and the following was observed. Observation of the three-year-old to four-year-old classroom at 8:29am revealed one (1) staff member working alone, supervising nineteen (19) children ages one-years-old to four-years-old. Continued observation at 8:30am revealed a second staff member enter the aforementioned classroom with a child, in which the three-year-old to four-year-old classroom exceeded the maximum group size from 8:30am until the surveyor left the classroom at 8:35am, in which two (2) employees were supervising twenty (20) children ages one-years-old to four-years-old.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview the child care center failed to comply with written documentation regulatory requirements. Review of documentation revealed a child (ED: 8/28/15) did not have an "infant gram" on file for 8/31/15. Interview with the director revealed the "infant gram" is filled out daily by employees and it documents what the child ate, mood, and diaper changes. Continued interview with the director revealed the "infant gram" for the above mentioned child for the date of 8/31/15 was given to his mother and the facility did not keep a copy on file.
