(4) A child shall:

- (a) Be helped with personal care and cleanliness based upon their developmental skills; and
- (b) Wash his or her hands with liquid soap and warm running water:
- 1. a. Upon arrival at the center; or
- b. Within thirty (30) minutes of arrival for school-age children;
- 2. Before and after eating or handling food;
- 3. After toileting or diaper change;
- 4. After handling animals;
- 5. After wiping or blowing nose;
- 6. After touching items soiled with body fluids or wastes; and
- 7. After outdoor or indoor play time.

# Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the center failed to maintain hygienic practices in accordance with regulations. Observation revealed a preschool child and a toddler's hands were not washed upon arrival to the center. Continued observation revealed the toddler's hands were not washed before he began eating breakfast. Further observation revealed at least two (2) preschool children and four (4) toddler's hands were not washed after breakfast.

## Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the child care center failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulations. Observation of the One-Year-Old Room revealed seven (7) one-year-olds were served a bowl of dry cereal and a sippy cup of whole milk. Continued observation revealed seven (7) bowls of mandarin oranges were prepared for the children, but the oranges were never served to the children as the children had finished eating their cereal and begun to play; therefore, the children's breakfast failed to include a fruit, vegetable, or 100% juice component.
