General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the center did not have current liability insurance on file. The liability insurance on file was valid 10/1/19 to 10/1/20.

(n) Assure that a person acting as a caregiver of a child in care shall not be left alone with a child, if the licensee has not received the results of the background checks as described in 922 KAR 2:280;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a review of documentation and interview, a caregiver hired 12/7/20, did not submit a child abuse/neglect check and was left alone to supervise five (5) children from 10:40 am to 1:00 pm in the school-age classroom.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, three (3) caregivers, hired 12/7/20, 6/15/20 and 3/27/20, did not have education documentation on file.



410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, a caregiver hired on 5/27/13, completed one and a half (1 1/2) hours of Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma (PHAT) training on 10/20/14, and did not complete the training again within five (5) years. A caregiver hired on 6/15/20, did not complete six (6) hours of orientation training.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the center failed to assure new staff shall undergo name-based background checks and shall not be left alone with children until name-based background checks have been approved and returned in accordance with 922 KAR 2:410E. A caregiver hired on 12/7/20, did not have documentation to verify a child abuse/neglect check had been submitted. The caregiver was left alone to care for five (5) children in the school-age classroom from 10:40 am to 1:00 pm.
