Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child-care center failed to meet this regulation. The surveyor found a paper towel dispenser located in classroom #103, that was not completely attached to the wall. The dispenser was found hanging by one screw.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor entered the cafeteria and found several ceiling tiles that were in disrepair. The surveyor observed water stains, discoloration, and black residue covering many of the tiles.

Additionally, there were three missing tiles and a couple of tiles that were not secured in place. The staff person in charge stated the damage was from the condensation from the air conditioning system. It is important to note, that the cafeteria space is used as a school-age classroom each day.

The surveyor also found a ceiling tile not secured in place over the diaper-changing table located in classroom #115.
