- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:

- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of the presented employee files revealed staff members with hire dates 8/14/17 and 8/8/17 whose files did not contain a high school diploma, GED or qualifying documentation for a comparable educational entity. The Director did not provide educational documentation for the employees at the time of the survey.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of the presented employee files revealed staff members with hire dates 8/10/17 and 8/8/17 whose files did not contain a statement from a health professional that the individuals were free from active tuberculosis. The Director did not provide a current statement for the employees at the time of the survey.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of the presented employee files revealed staff members with hire dates 10/1/15 and 8/1/16 whose files did not contain documentation to verify the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training had been completed. Review of the ECE-TRIS report verified that the staff members did not complete the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training. The Director did not provide documentation to verify that the staff members had completed fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training. Continued review of the presented employee files revealed a staff member with hire date 8/1/16 whose file did not contain documentation to verify that she had completed the six (6) hours of cabinet approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment.

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. There was a hole in one of the ceiling tiles in Mrs. Church's Three-Year-Old Room located above the art center. The vent in the first stall by the toilet in the bathroom located by room 207 was not secured to the wall and had a nail protruding from the vent.

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain children's records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of the presented children's files revealed a child with enrollment date 3/3/17 whose file did not contain the name of the family's preferred hospital. The Director did not provide the documentation at the time of the survey.
