Review of the presented employee records revealed two (2) staff members with the same hire date of 8/21/18 whose file did not contain a high school diploma, GED or other qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity. Upon request, the director did not present educational documentation for the aforementioned staff members at the time of the

Upon request, the director did not present current statements for the aforementioned staff members at the time of the survey.

Review of the presented employee records revealed two (2) staff members with hire dates 8/8/17 and 8/1/16 whose file did not contain documentation to verify completion of the required six (6) hours of cabinet approved orientation. Continued review of the presented employee records revealed a staff member with hire date 8/8/17 whose file did not contain documentation to verify completion of the required nine (9) hours of cabinet approved training. Review of ECE-TRIS verified that the staff member had not completed the nine (9) hours of cabinet approved training. Upon request, the director did not present training documentation for the aforementioned staff members at the time of the survey.
