General: Based on review of documentation, observation and interview, the child care center failed to comply with regulatory background checks requirements. Review of the presented employee records revealed one (1) staff members with hire date 8/1/15 whose background checks listed Mississippi as previous residences in the past five years and did not contain a Mississippi background check. Upon request, the director did not present a Mississippi background check for the aforementioned staff members at the time of the survey. Observation of the child care center revealed the aforementioned staff member was not working alone with children. Interview with the staff in charge revealed the staff member had not worked alone with children.

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. Review of staff files revealed an annual written performance evaluation was not presented for review at the time of survey for eight (8) staff members hired 10/1/15, 8/6/18, 8/1/16, 8/8/17, 8/14/17, 8/21/18, 8/1/16 and 8/21/18. Interview with director revealed an evaluation had not been completed for the aforementioned staff members.

Review of staff files and an ECE-TRIS report on 9/12/19 revealed one (1) staff member with a hire date of 8/21/18 had not completed cabinet approved orientation training. Interview with the staff in charge revealed this documentation was not on file at the time of survey.

Observation of the Four's Room revealed a staff cell phone and a container of disinfecting wipes labeled keep out of reach of children were located on a table accessible to children. Continued observation revealed that in the Three's Room a staff cell phone and a bottle of hand sanitizer labeled keep out of reach of children were located on a table accessible to children.
