General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the outside trim of the door at the threshhold, coming in from the small playground, revealed rotting wood with sharp, rough edges and peeling paint.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation revealed a staff member taking four (4) children, boys and girls, into the restroom, without providing a separate toilet room for each gender, or using the toilet room at separate times.
