350 - Health, Safety, Comfort Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 10. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

- (1) A director shall:
- (I) Assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

Findings:

General: Based on interviews, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. Interview with staff failed to reveal corrective action was taken after a toddler was stung multiple times while in a playhouse on the playground, to prevent the occurrence from happening again. The playhouse remained in the playarea resulting in the same child being stung multiple times ten (10) days later. Thus, the director failed to assure the health, safety and comfort of the child.

Premises Not In Compliance

570 - Pest Control Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (7) Measures shall be utilized to control the presence of:
- (a) Rodents;
- (b) Flies;
- (c) Roaches; and
- (d) Other vermin.

Findings:

General: Based on interview, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Interviews revealed a toddler was stung on two (2) separate occasions by wasps while playing in a playhouse on the playground. Interviews failed to reveal that preventative action was taken after the first occurrence, resulting in the toddler being stung multiple times, ten (10) days later.

Outdoor Play Area

Not In Compliance 750 - Playground Conditions **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (20) An outdoor play area shall be:
- (d) Safe from foreseeable hazard;
- (e) Well drained;
- (f) Well maintained;
- (g) In good repair; and
- (h) Visible to staff at all times.

Findings:

General: Based on interviews, the child care center failed to maintain the outdoor play area in accordance with regulatory requirements. Interviews with staff revealed that a playhouse containing wasps/bees that had stung a toddler multiple times on 08/06/19 remained in the play area, thereby failing to remove the source of the hazard, and allowing the toddler to be stung multiple times again on 08/15/19.



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
