- 1.) One staff hired on 10/1/21, did not have documentation of negative TB results prior to employment on file.
- 2.) One adult in the home did not have documentation of negative TB results on file. The previous TB results expired on 1/9/22.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, the thermometer in the refrigerator was registering 50 degrees. A refrigerator used to store children's food should not be over 40 degrees in order to prevent spoilage.
