Findings:

General: Based on Observation, at the time of the visit conducted on 7/10/18 a tour of the facility was taken. During that time a group of school age children were observed using a General: Based on Observation, at the time of the Visit conducted on /1/10/18 a tour of the facility was taken. During that time a group of school age children were observed using a room located on the third floor of the building. An accordion style room divider was observed attached to the far end of the wall but was pushed back against the wall leaving access to both sides of the large room. The children were observed in both spaces and staff in the room stated that the children eat lunch on one (1) side and do activities on the other side. A review of documentation found that facility had submitted a request on 3/15/17 to add an additional space of 882 square feet to their current space. A review of the diagram from a visit conducted on 3/30/17 shows one half (1/2) of the room with a capacity of twenty-five (25) as being approved. The space where it was stated the children eat their lunch was not approved.
