General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that two staff did not have evidence of completing Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training within the last five years. The dates of hire for these staff are 10/02/2015 and 01/17/2017. A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed these findings.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following;

- 1. A hole, the size of a golf ball, in the wall adjacent to the diapering area located in toddler classroom 204;
- 2. Excessive chipped paint on the wall next to the indoor climber located in toddler classroom 202;
- 3. Areas of cracked linoleum in preschool classroom 206;
- 4. A section of baseboard not secured to the wall in preschool classroom 206; and
- 5. Numerous stains embedded in the wall-to-wall carpeting in the little discovery camp classroom.

- 2. Excessive tape residue on a shelving unit located in toddler classroom 204 and on a shelving unit, a red table and dramatic play table located in preschool classroom 206;
- 3. Excessive tape residue on the wall at the entrance of preschool classroom 206; and
- 4. Numerous stains on an area rug located in the little discovery camp classroom.
