General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that a staff member hired on 8/22/2022, did not obtain a TB test or statement from a health professional until 9/9/2022.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, two staff members hired 4/20/2022, and 8/15/2022, did not have evidence of completing the required CPR/First Aid training on file at the facility. A review of ECE-TRIS records supports the information found during the survey.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1.) The carpet in the Room 102 and Room 206 was ripped.
- 2.) The wall around the urinal in the Boy's bathroom downstairs was in disrepair. It appeared the urinal was coming off the wall.
- 3.) The wall around the sinks in the Boy's and Girl's bathrooms downstairs had chipped paint.
