General: Based on observation, it was found though a tour of the facility that an additional classroom was being used. This additional classroom was not inspected by a DRCC surveyor. Upon speaking with the director, it was found that no one in DRCC was notified of this addition of space.

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that two (2) staff files did not contain evidence of a current TB test or physician's statement. Hires dates for these staff are 08/21/2006 and 09/01/2017.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that two (2) staff did not complete the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training. The hire date for both staff is 08/21/2006. A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed this.

General: Based on observation, it was found through a tour of the rainbow classroom that there was a cup of coffee located on top of the teacher's desk. Therefore, it was accessible to the children in the classroom.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings

General: Based on observation, it was found through a tour of the bathroom in the preschool classroom that there was a small water stain on a ceiling tile. This tile was located in the back corner of the bathroom.
