General: Based on review of documentation and interview, a caregiver hired on 8/9/21, did not have TB documentation on file. A caregiver hired on 11/17/11, had TB documentation on file that was dated 9/16/17.

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, caregivers hired 7/30/20, 9/14/20, and 5/13/21, each did not complete six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation training within the first three (3) months of employment. **Programming**

General: Based on observation and interview, three (3) cans of Sprayway Glass Cleaner and a can of Lysol were stored in an unlocked cabinet in the boys' restroom. A gallon of Clorox Bleach was stored in an unlocked cabinet in the three-year-olds' room. These items were accessible to children.
