## Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the child care center failed to comply with staffing requirements. Upon entrance at 08:47 a.m., there was one (1) staff present working alone with twenty-eight (28) children, ranging in age from five to twelve years old. At 08:53 a.m., three (3) additional children arrived leaving one (1) staff alone with thirty-one (31) children. At 09:32, a second staff member arrived at the center placing the center in compliance. Therefore, the staff to child ratio was out of compliance by sixteen (16) children from 08:53 a.m. to 09:32 a.m.

### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the staff in charge did not provide verification of a menu that had been posted in advance in a conspicuous space and made available to the parents.

### Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the child care center failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulatory requirements. Based on observation at 11: 00 a.m., the lunch that was served did not meet all of the required components. The children were not offered or served pasteurized skim or low fat 1% milk.

- (b) Each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year;
- (c) Information on the Kentucky Consumer Product Safety Program and the program's website as specified in KRS 199.897;
- (d) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including:
- 1. Current rates for child care; and
- 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;
- (e) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and
- (f) Daily schedule.

### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, the child care center failed to post documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the child care director did not present verification that each statement of deficiency issued by the cabinet during the current licensure year and each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year was readily accessible for public inspection. Review of the postings revealed no current statement of deficiencies was present.
