General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, the staff in charge did not present verification that the out of state background check had been completed for the employee with the hire date of 12/17/2019. Review of the educational certificate in the employee's file revealed that it was issued in 2019, from the state of South Carolina. The staff was not working alone.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, there was no indication there was a ventilation system that was operational in the restroom located inside the two-year-old classroom. Observation of the restroom located inside the five-year-old room revealed that behind the base of the toilet, there were several tiles that had "caved" into the wall, leaving an open gap. The restroom floor in the four-year-old classroom had a grimy build up in-between the tiles on the floor.
