- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE - TRIS, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) Staff (DOH: 10/24/10) has not obtained the one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training.
- (2.) Staff (DOH: 10/17/16) has not obtained the one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training.
- (3.) Staff (DOH: 8/15/16) obtained the one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training on 10/2/17. The training was not obtained during the staff's first year of employment.
