General: Based on observation, during a tour of the six (6) to twelve (12) month old children's classroom, the surveyor observed cords dangling from a TV. The cords were not connected and were hanging low enough for a child to grab and pull; thus, creating a safety hazard to the children.

- 1. A staff member (DOH: 08/28/13) had not completed fifteen (15) hours of approved training as required. A review of ECE-TRIS found that the staff member had obtained thirteen (13) hours of training during the annual training year of 08/23/15-08/23/16. There was no additional training documentation in the staff members file.
- 2. A staff member (DOH: 08/20/14) had not completed fifteen (15) hours of approved training as required. A review of ECE-TRIS found that the staff member had obtained thirteen (13) hours of training during the annual training year of 08/20/15-08/20/16. There was no additional training documentation in the staff members file.

- (3) A serving of milk shall consist of:
- (a) Breast milk or iron-fortified formula for a child age birth to twelve (12) months;
- (b) Pasteurized whole milk for children ages twelve (12) months to twenty-four (24) months; or
- (c) Pasteurized low fat one (1) percent or fat-free skim milk for children ages twenty-four (24) months to school-age.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, during a tour of a six (6) to twelve (12) month old children's classroom, the surveyor found a quart jar of milk in the refrigerator. In an interview with staff, the surveyor was informed that the parent had changed their eleven (11) month old child's milk to whole milk. There was no written notification of the change from the parent in the child's file and staff confirmed that the parent had not submitted a written request for the change.
