#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor initially entered the one-year-old classroom at approximately 1:10 pm and found country music playing on the radio while the children were asleep on their cots. The surveyor went back to the classroom after the children woke up from nap at 2:10 pm and the same country station was playing on the radio while the children ate their snack. This music is not developmentally appropriate for the one-year-old classroom.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the kitchen door was open at the time of the survey and there were two jugs of hand sanitizer and one jug of bleach found underneath the unlocked kitchen sink cabinet. There was also a large knife found in an unlocked drawer and a closet had numerous bottles of bleach, Lysol and other cleaning supplies. All of these items were accessible to the children.

- 2) There were several spots of drywall mud found on the walls in the one-year-old classroom.
