Staff person hired 11/20/17 did not have the results of or evidence of the application for a criminal background check on file in the facility. The staff person was not alone with children. 2. Staff person hired 10/10/17 had the results of a criminal records check dated 10/27/17. There was no evidence on file that the application for the check had been submitted prior to employment as required. 3. staff person hired 7/17/17 had the results of a criminal records check dated 7/26/17. There was no evidence on file that the application for the check had been submitted prior to employment as required. 4. Staff person hired 10/10/17 had the results of a CA/N check dated 10/24/17. There was no evidence on file that the application for the check had been submitted within the first five (5) days of employment as required. 5. Staff person hired 11/20/17 had the results of a CA/N check dated 12/4/17. There was no evidence on file that the application for the check had been submitted within the first five (5) days of employment as required. 6. Staff person hired 7/17/17 had the results of a CA/N check dated 7/25/17. There was no evidence on file that the application for the check had been submitted within the first five (5) days of employment as required.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, staff persons hired 10/10/17 and 3/20/17 did not have documentation of negative T.B. results on file in the facility that had been obtained within the past two (2) years.

General: Based on Observation, a spray bottle of a bleach/water solution was being stored on a lower shelf in the Older Twos classroom. The bottle was accessible to the children in care

General: Based on Observation, the diapering mat in the boys' bathroom was torn in in a few places, leaving exposed foam that can not be properly sanitized between uses.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, there were two (2) mats used by the children at nap time that were torn in the Older Twos classroom. The tears left exposed foam that can not be properly sanitized after use.

755 - Toys/Equipment/Furniture

- (1) All toys, equipment, and furniture contacted by a child shall be:
- (a) Kept clean and in good repair; and
- (b) Free of peeling, flaking, or chalking paint.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the door to a three (3) feet tall plastic cabinet was not secured to the unit in the Younger Twos classroom. A child pulled on the cabinet door to open it and the entire door came off of the cabinet.
