General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the family care home failed to maintain provider records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the provider did not present verification that the file for the adult residing in the home had a completed child abuse or neglect check. Review of the document revealed the back page with the CAN results was not present.

Upon request, the provider did not provide verification that the adult residing in the home had a current copy of a statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or a copy of negative tuberculin results.

Upon request, the child care provider did not present verification that the enrollment record for a child with the enrollment date of 12/17/2015 contained a current copy of immunization certificate.

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the family care home failed to maintain written documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the child care provider did not provide verification that the monthly fire drill had been conducted for December of 2017.
