Based on observation, CCL found that the outdoor area was not designed so that all parts are visible and easily supervised by staff. There was a small area to the left of the white shed that could not be supervised by staff.

The Plan of Correction was accepted on 12-20-17.

No 13. Health Prevention

37.95.183(2)(a-g)

- (2) A first aid kit must be kept on site at all times and must at a minimum contain:
 - (a) Unexpired syrup of ipecac (one ounce bottle) which may be administered only upon directive from the Emergency Montana Poison Control Center or upon directive of the local emergency service program (i.e., 911 operator, local hospital, or physician);
 - (b) Sterile, absorbent bandages;
 - (c) A cold pack;
 - (d) Tape and a variety of band-aids;
 - (e) Tweezers and scissors;
 - (f) The toll free number for the Emergency Montana Poison Control Center, 1(800) 222-1222;
 - (g) Disposable single use gloves.

The intent of this rule was not met:

Based on review of first aid kit, CCL found that the facility first aid kits did not contain the following items: scissors, poison control number and a cold pac.
