Based on observation and interview on 12/31/19 at 11:45am CCL observed the fire extinguisher was placed on a child size table near the sliding glass door and not mounted. Provider reported she had not been told previously that she needed to have it mounted.

The intent of this rule was not met:

Based on observation and interview on 12/31/19 AT 11:50AM, CCL found that the outdoor area was not free of hazards. A hot tub was observed in the outside play area. The hot tub was empty but had a lid on it that wasn't locked. A child could get into the hot tub and not be able to get out.
