A review of all required documentation should be conducted to confirm that documentation exists and common information is consistent across all documents for each child.

#### The intent of this rule was not met:

Based on observation and interview, CCL found that there were fourteen children in care. Facility is currently approved for twelve children; therefore, only twelve children should have been in care.

If individual battery-operated smoke detectors are used, the following maintenance is required:

Based on observation, CCL found that a smoke detector was not installed in the napping room.

# 7. Play Area No

37.95.121.6.:Any outdoor play area must be maintained free from hazards such as wells, machinery and animal waste. If any part of the play area is adjacent to a busy roadway, drainage or irrigation ditch, stream, large holes, or other hazardous areas, the play area must be enclosed with a fence in good repair that is at least 4 feet high without any holes or spaces greater than 4 inches in diameter or natural barriers to restrict children from these areas.

# The intent of this rule was not met:

Based on observation, CCL found that:

- the outdoor area was not enclosed, with a fence that is at least 4 feet high with holes or spaces no greater than 4 inches in diameter, between the house and the garage. This could allow children access to areas not supervised.
- the outdoor area contained several puddles that contained water that could be a drowning hazard as well as a breeding site for mosquitoes.

37.95.183.: FIRST AID REQUIREMENTS

#### Deficiency

- (2) A first aid kit must be kept on site at all times and must contain:
  - a. sterile, absorbent bandages;
  - b. a cold pack;
  - c. tape and a variety of band-aids;
  - d. tweezers and scissors;
  - e. disposable single use gloves
- (5) A portable first aid kit containing at least the items listed in (2) must accompany staff and children on trips away from the facility.

### The intent of this rule was not met:

Based on observation and interview, CCL found that the facility first aid kit did not contain a chemical cold pack and there did not appear to be a complete portable first aid kit.
